JAMAICA, NEW YORK, March 1, 2023 – Queens Centers for Progress (QCP) brought together more than 500 people for the 27th annual "Evening of Fine Food" on February 28, an evening celebrating community, resilience, and the value of giving.

The in-person event at Terrace on the Park in Flushing Meadows-Corona Park, Queens, raised more than \$120,000 to support the longtime organization's programs and services, assisting more than 1,200 individuals with developmental disabilities to lead more independent lives.
